A diminished Science Fair will go on with volunteer efforts until new partners are found.





Partner Return on Investment

Program Endowment: (\$10 Million)

Provides continuing future operational expenses for the Science Fair in Los Angeles County. Will support 1,000 – 2,000 students each year at an annual Event. Provides for 10-15% growth rate.

Full Partner: (\$130,000)

Provides general operational expenses for the Science Fair in Los Angeles County. Will support 1,000 – 1,200 students at the 2011 Event.

Co Partner: (\$65,000)

Provides <u>shared</u> operational expenses for the Science Fair in Los Angeles County.

Science Fair Sponsorships

- \$ 25,000 30,000
 Provides meals for staff, volunteers, judges, guests.
- \$ 10,000 15,000
 Provides awards, certificates and event presentation.
- \$ 20,000 Provides college mentoring support for 50-60 students-of-need.
- \$5,000 10,000
 Provides security, publicity, parking.
- \$ 1,000 4,000

Provides office operations (Equipment rental, supplies, etc.)

• \$ 200 - 2,000

Provides sponsorship for school registration "hardship" cases.

• \$ 1,000

Provides banners and signage.
